

Emily Lively Scholarship Application

The Emily Lively Scholarship is designed to assist individuals which have been absent from the labor market for an extended period of time. Awards are based on actual need for assistance, initiative, and attitude as determined by the class instructor. Documentation of absence from labor market may be required. Funds are to be used for tuition, fees, and books.

Students interested in applying for the Emily Lively Scholarship must demonstrate financial need and should first apply for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Scholarships will be awarded on a semester basis and a new application must be submitted at that time to be eligible.

Applicants must:

- 1. Provide a statement of financial need in addition to completion of FAFSA online.
- 2. Submit a brief essay explaining the contribution you intend to make upon completion of your program with the assistance of this scholarship. **Essay must be attached.**
