RAM Forward Lively Technical College Scholarship Program

Eligibility requirements:

- 1. Florida resident and Leon County high school senior student within 90 days of graduation. Must show proof of graduation prior to award of scholarship.
- 2. Student must demonstrate financial need.
- 3. Participant must submit a brief essay explaining their intended use of the construction skills they plan to develop at Lively Technical College and how this scholarship can help achieve that goal. Additional paper may be attached to complete the essay; not to exceed 600 words, Calibri 12 font.

Scholarship Submission Period

RAM will offer this scholarship to one individual within a 90 day period prior to and 30 days after the Leon County Schools annual High School graduation date. The posted date plus 30 calendar days of the Leon High School graduation will be the scholarship application final date of submission acceptance. No applications will be accepted after that date.

Scholarship will cover the cost of:

RAM will pay directly pay Lively Technical College the scholarship student's 900-hour tuition only for the Building Trades & Construction Design Technology course. Tuition will be paid by semester and students must maintain good attendance and academic standing in order for remaining tuition to be paid.

Systematic review process:

- I. Quality Control: In this stage, RAM will review and prescreen applications to make sure they are filled out properly and meet scholarship requirements.
- II. Select the Finalist. RAM will select qualified applicants whom deliver the most compelling essay.
- III. Evaluate the Finalist: RAM will appoint 3 application reviewers known as the "Review Committee" to score the "Finalist" applicants submission with a scoring range of 1 to 100 points based on responses to the following items below. These scores will be averaged and the applicant with the highest score will be awarded the scholarship.

Evaluation Score Sheet Criteria (Scored 1-100 points)

Financial need for scholarship

A cohesive and compelling narrative

Demonstrate building related hobbies/life experiences/interests

Clear passion for their professional future

The RAM *Forward* Scholarship was designed to assist Leon County School graduating students who demonstrate financial need and willingness to enter the construction field of work. Applicants who have construction skills and have either volunteered or currently work in a construction related job will be given special consideration.

Application and Essay Submission: Scholarship application to be submitted via email to info@ramflorida.com

Scholarship Offer Period: RAM will offer this scholarship to one individual within a 90 day period prior to and 30 days after the Leon County Schools annual High School graduation date. No applications will be accepted after that date.

Scholarship Offer: RAM will pay the scholarship to Lively Technical College directly. The scholarship award will be applied to a students account for the unmet need related to tuition of the **Building Trades & Construction Design Technology** program and will be paid by semester. Student must maintain good attendance and academic standing in order to remain eligible for the scholarship. A minimum half-time enrollment is required.

Students interested in applying for the RAM *Forward* scholarship must demonstrate financial need and should first apply for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.ed.gov.

Applicants must:

- 1. Be enrolled in a Leon County School (private and charter schools are not eligible) and graduating within 90 days or 30 days post graduation. Must be a resident of the state of Florida. Scholarship recipient must show proof of graduation prior to enrollment.
- Submit a brief essay (not to exceed 600 words, Calibri 12 font) explaining your financial need for the scholarship, building related hobbies/volunteering/life experiences/interest, and construction professional future plans upon completion of the Lively Technical College Building Trades & Construction Design Technology program. Additional paper may be attached for completed essay.
