

SUCCESS FOR OCCUPATIONAL AREA READINESS

The SOAR program is an inclusive, one-year certificate program offering a post-secondary experience to students identified with an intellectual disability on the campus of Lively Technical College.

SOAR ELIGIBILITY:

Students eligible for the SOAR program must provide proof of an intellectual disability. Potential students are young men and women who aim to become independent, productive, working members of society. SOAR students are able to effectively read and write, manage a busy schedule, and navigate the campus. Eligible students should have the ability to work successfully with other students.

*All eligible students must have independent living skills.

ACADEMICS:

Students will participate in general courses with non-disabled peers in one of the following certificate programs:

- Automotive Service Technology
- Nails Specialty
- Facials Specialty
- Heating Ventilation Air Conditioning/Refrigeration Technology
- Building Trades & Construction Design Technology or
- Fundamental Foodservice Skills.

Part-time and full-time hours are available for the above programs.

- Specialized Career Instruction

This program is individualized for each student and documented in an Individualized Plan of Study (IPS).

Monday - Thursday, 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

SUPPORTS:

Special supports for students eligible for the SOAR program include career counseling, case specialists, and modified learning plans – dependent upon need.

EMPLOYMENT NEEDS:

Lively Technical College partners with Vocational Rehabilitation, CareerSource and Agency for Persons with Disabilities to address employment needs such as career planning, internships/work based learning opportunities (paid and unpaid), completing resumes, interview skills, and job placement (with support).
