



The Terrell Family Memorial Scholarship Application

The Terrell Family Memorial Scholarship provides financial assistance to **full-time returning** students enrolled in a Health Education or Welding Program based on academic achievement. The scholarship is intended to help offset the cost of tuition and fees. If all fees are covered by other funding, the student may receive the scholarship in a check. The maximum award is **\$500**.

Scholarship recipients will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Satisfactory attendance
- Satisfactory academic progress
- Demonstrated leadership qualities
- Completion of a minimum 250-word essay. Applications submitted without the required essay will not be considered. **Essay Prompt:** *Describe what you plan to accomplish with your certification or license and how you plan to give back to your community.*
